Albert Park Gang— Cash and Weapons Seized

A man stopped by police in the vicinity of Albert Park Yacht Club was found to be carrying a cache of weapons (pictured) and a large amount of cash.

The suspect is believed to be part of a sophisticated gang selling Class A addictive substances outside Port Melbourne Bunnings. Police described the gang as operating in a manner consistent with corner drug gangs in the United States, even to the extent of supplying substances to drive by customers, and wearing club or gang colours.

It is expected that members of the gang will be subject to further investigation.
